BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Read these instructions and check to be sure all parts and tools are accounted. Please retain these installation instructions for future reference.

IMPORTANT

This FRONT MESH GRILLE KIT is exclusively designed for your vehicle. Please read the installation instructions thoroughly before beginning. Installation is easier if the vehicle is clean and free of debris.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.



2. Attach the letter X3 to the mesh plate using two M4*12 hex socket screws and two M4 lock nuts.



3. Remove the front fascia, open the side cover panel, and remove the two screws on each side along with the two screws on the inner side (keep the removed parts for later use).

4. Remove the two screws at the front of the vehicle (keep the screws for later use), open the front cover plate, and remove the two screws connecting it to the radiator frame (keep the screws for later use).



5. Unscrew the headlight bolts, disconnect the wiring harness connector, and remove the front fascia panel.




6. Remove the original plastic front grille.



8. Tighten and secure the headlight screws. Install the wiring harness. Reinstall the front fascia plastic components onto the vehicle frame following the same steps used during disassembly. Verify all screws are properly tightened.



7. Assemble the center section of the metal grille to the front fascia using two M6*35 hex socket screws, two slightly shorter aluminum posts, two M6 flat washers, and lock nuts. Connect the ends of the metal grille to the front fascia using two M6*60 hex socket screws, two longer aluminum posts, two M6 flat washers, and lock nuts, as shown in the illustration.

9. Installation complete.
